The pick up we thought we could do for ourselves, wondering vaguely just whose car this was becoming. We found out...

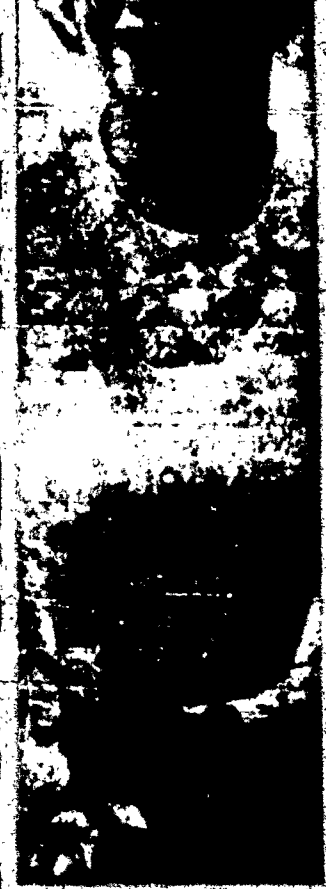
"Here's your car, Ma'am," as we paid the bill, "Isn't she a honey? Your daughter sure knows how to pick colors!"
