CYO In The News

C.Y.O. will hold its classes "Tiny Tot" and "Learn To Swim" again this summer.

The "Tiny Tot" classes for four to six year olds will begin on Tuesday, June 23, at 10:15 a.m. Wednesday, June 24, at 10:15 a.m. and Friday, June 26, at 10:15 a.m. These classes will run for five weeks.

"Learn To Swim" classes for six to 14 year olds will begin on Wednesday, June 26, at 7 p.m. and will continue until August 26th (ten weeks). To register call Mrs. Osborn at the C.Y.O., HA 5-2107.

This summer, the Catholic Youth Organization will conduct five different day camps throughout Rochester. The day camps will be located at the downtown C.Y.O., St. Andrew's Parish, 923 Portland Ave., St. Augustine, Parish, 410 Chili Ave., Holy Family Parish, 1211 Ave. and Christ the King Parish, Kings Highway.

All but the downtown camp will run from July 8 through August 30, 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. The downtown camp will start June 24 and end August 30.

A highly qualified staff has been hired this year to run the different day camps, and many new and exciting activities are planned for the camping season. Some of the activities will include pony riding, swimming at the C.Y.O. pool, visits by Indians to the campsites, a softball league between the camps, canoeing, hikes, a day camp olympic among all camps, and many arts and crafts.

Registration fee of all the camps is \$5, which covers the cost of the camp insurance, a camp t-shirt and a camp hat. The camp fee is \$7.50 per week, \$15 for a two week period. If a camper registers for weeks, the fee is then \$25 plus registration. If the child registers for the entire 8-week camping session, the fee is then \$45, plus the \$5 registration fee. The age of the campers will be from 6 to 13 years of age.
