The 95th Annual Sunday Memorial Service in the Shrine Room of Community War Memorial, Sunday May 26 at 3 p.m. will open the observance of Memorial Week and the street parade on Memorial Day, Thursday, May 30. The memorial Building shrine will pay tribute to departed servicemen and women.

Besides the many Catholic servicemen and women, various military bands will head the parade with their various units. In line also will be Nazareth Hall Cadets, Knights of St. John and Ladies Auxiliary, The Catholic War Veterans and CWV Auxiliaries, the Holy Cross Marching Band.
