Basion --- (NC) --- A sociolo rist said here a basic change from the "Jesus-and-me" in the attitudes of American Catholics has been effected during the 20th contury.

John D. Domovan, chairman of Boston College's sociology department told the 27th annual diocessan meeting of the League of Catholic Women the "Jesusand-me" attitude which charace terized Catholics here in the 19th century was one that hardened their courage in the face of persecution but closed their hearts and minds to the fulness of the Divine Word."

This attitude, which can be ummed up in the idea, "Christ was born and died for me," led to "A kind of withdrawal and moral indifference to the rest of God's creation" and focused "only on the goal of personal salvation," Donovan said.
