SISTER CHRISTINE MARY is the former Mary Christina de Ycaza. She attended Ithaca Senior High School and St. Agnes High School in Rochester. She is a graduate of D'Youville College in Buffalo and the past year taught at St. Rose of Lima School in Buffalo.

The four are the first Grey Nuns to serve in South America. The establishment of the mission school in Lima is in accordance with the late Pope John's request that all religious orders send 10 per cent of their members to South America over the next ten years.
