

Livonia Center Church Schedules 35th Dinner

Livonia Center—Members of St. Michael's, Little White Church on the Hill and St. Mary's of Honeyoye, are concentrating on inviting their friends and relatives from near and far to their 35th annual Turkey Dinner and Festival on Saturday, Aug. 10.

Plans are made to accommodate 1500 guests, 300 more than last year because of the number that had to be turned away. As in the past, serving will be in a large dining tent on the grounds of St. Michael's, Route 20A between Homlock and Livonia.

Cooperation and concentrated effort on the part of the parishioners from both churches have made it possible for the two comparatively small churches to keep abreast of its fame, according to Father Walter Caron, pastor.

The first dinner was served under the direction of the late

Father John Smith in 1928, from the kitchens of the Dwyer home, next to the church. Each housewife prepared her share of the dinner in her own home because of lack of facilities at the church.

Through the years with the modernization of the church building, the use of big tents, electric stoves and equipment, tables and dishes the dinner can be handled in a professional and scientific manner.

This year new improvements specifically for the serving of the hot food have been made in the kitchen through the courtesy of Willie Johnson and his sons, Mark and Bart of St. Mary's Church.

Serving will be in at 4:30 p.m. and continue until late in the evening.

Head of the kitchen committee is Mrs. Thomas Feilbush, chairman. Other members include Mrs. Alice Dwyer, Mrs. Edward Philpott, Mrs. C. Patterson, Mrs. Freda Lamaye, Mrs. Edward Mianichin, John Jenkins, Henry Gessner, Arthur Hohmann, Herbert Schuster, and Edward Nighan.

The festival part of the event will include approximately 15 booths, a fish pond and merry-go-round for the little tots.

The entire list of workers includes names of the welcome new helpers, people of the neighboring community as well as members of both churches, who return to the same post year after year.

Abp. Byrne Funeral Held in Santa Fe

Santa Fe, N.M.—(NC)—Requiem Mass was offered here for Archbishop Edwin V. Byrne of Santa Fe, 71, spiritual leader since 1943 of the historic Santa Fe archdiocese.

DEATH CAME (July 25) to the Philadelphia-born prelate in St. Vincent's Hospital, here following surgery. The Requiem Mass was offered (July 31) in the venerable cathedral of St. Francis by Bishop Sidney M. Metzger of El Paso, Tex.

Before he became spiritual leader of the 19-year-old archdiocese's 200,000 Catholics, about half of the population, he spent five years in the Philippines and 18 years as a Bishop in Puerto Rico. He was the first Bishop of Ponce from 1928 to 1929 and Bishop of San Juan from 1929 until 1943.

Born in Philadelphia on August 9, 1891, the son of Francis C. and Anna (Carroll) Byrne, the future Bishop entered St. Charles Borromeo Seminary, Overbrook Pa., at the age of 15. He was ordained on May 22, 1915, in Philadelphia.

After serving two years as a Navy chaplain in World War I, he became secretary to Bishop James P. McCloskey of Jaro in the Philippines. He remained there until named Bishop of Ponce, P.R., in 1925.

He was consecrated in Philadelphia's Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul on November 30, 1925, in a ceremony at which the late Bishop Edmund Fitzmaurice of Wilmington also was consecrated.
