### New Hospital In Selma Staffed By St. Joseph Nuns

The new Good Samaritan Hospital, Selma, Ala., is the culmination of five years of diligent work and planning on the part of Sister, Louis Dorfman, S.S.L., the Hospital Administrator, and the Very Rev. Eymard P. Galligan, S.S.E., Mission Director of the Fathers of St. Edmund.

The Good Samaritan Hospital School of Practical Nursing was established in 1959, the first of its kind for both white and colored in Alabama. Since its opening, the school has been licensed by the State Board of Nurse Examiners and the graduates are eligible to take the state examination qualifying them as licensed practical nurses.

There have been 224 graduates who have secured and held positions all over the United States. Many of the graduates do general staff nursing, some are head nurses, and a few have teaching positions. One of the graduates has been accepted in the Peace Corps.

OVER THE period of nineteen years that the Sisters of St. Joseph have been working in the Hospital, much prejudice has been broken down. People who had not known what it was to speak to a Sister now come for assistance and advice. Over a thousand dying babies, children, and elderly patients have been baptized and many have been brought into the Church.

Five Sisters now staff Good Samaritan Hospital, and four Sisters staff St. Elizabeth's School, Sister Mary Paul is the Superior of the Sisters in Selma.

### State AAU Track Meet Set In Elmira Aug. 10

New York State AAU Track and Field Championships will be held for the third straight year at Elmira.

The third annual State Meet, sponsored by the Elmira A. C. Track Club and cosponsored by the Amateur Athletic Union, will be held Saturday August 10 at Elmira's Parker Field.

This year's pole vault competition may be the best yet and a new mark should be set. A new hard-surface, all-weather track is being installed.

More than 200 athletes representing 14 clubs from all corners of the state, participated in the 1962 event.

In the 1963 meet, 11 records (six) and four marks were set in events new to the State Championships.

The Garden Town Track Club of Buffalo captured the team title in both '61 and '62, winning by 10 points the first year, but battling down to the final event on last year's card—the 800-yard relay—to edge out the New York Pioneer Club by one point.

CLUBS TAKING part last year from the New York City area were: The New York Athletic Club, the New York Pioneer Club, the Grand Street Boys, the Tarrytown Spiked Shoe Club, the Bruce Track Club of The Bronx, the United Athletic Association of Brooklyn and the Police Athletic League. The New Utrecht Spiked Shoe Club of Brooklyn entered in 1961.

The Upstate clubs included Garden Town, Rochester Track Club, the Syracuse Olympic Club, the York A. C. of Buffalo, the Duffy Rapids of Buffalo and the Elmira A. C. of Track Club. In 1961, the Bennett Athletic Club and the Park Pioneers, both of Buffalo, were represented.

Sixteen of the 19 events are for men, three for women.


