### Pope Changes Official Title

Vatican City — (NC) — His Holiness Pope Paul VI has given instructions that the traditional formula used in reference to himself in all official publications of the Holy See and in the terms of the Holy Father.

IN THE PAST the formula "La Santa di Nostro Signore" (the holiness of Our Lord) has been used in the official notices printed in the periodical, *Acta Apostolicae Sedis* (Official Acts of the Holy See) and *L'Osservatore Romano*, Vatican City daily.

The formula was dropped for the first time in the August 8 edition of *L'Osservatore Romano*, and the text formal term, "the Holy Father" used instead.

All Vatican offices as well as the two publications had been informed that Pope Paul considered the old formula "rather antiquated" and that it is to be replaced by the form he considers more in keeping with the times.

### Deaf Institute Launches Drive

St. Louis — (NC) — St. Joseph Institute for the Deaf here has launched a drive to raise \$200,000 for a new building program. An additional \$300,000 will come from Federal Hill-Burton funds and available institute funds.

The first school for the deaf west of the Mississippi, the St. Joseph Institute was founded in 1887 by Sisters of St. Joseph. Today it has 70 day students and 90 boarders from 29 states and Canada.

### Birthday Noted By Pontiff

Vatican City — (NC) — Pope Paul VI has sent a letter of congratulations to Fernando Cardinal Cento, Grand Penitentiary, on his 60th birthday.

CARDINAL CENTO heads the Sacred Apostolic Penitentiary, high church court whose jurisdiction includes such matters as absolutions and dispensations, cases of conscience and indulgences.

The Pope's letter said: "We pray that constantly stronger in faith, comforted by hope and diligent in the service of charity, you may continue to live a long and active life."
