Knights of St. John Unit Marks 90th Anniversary

Ninetyth anniversary of Commandery 43, Knights of St. John of St. Michael's Church, Rochester will be fittingly observed Saturday and Sunday, Oct. 5 and 6.

The knights and ladies auxiliary members will attend a Requiem Mass in St. Michael's Church, Saturday evening, Oct. 5, at 8:30 p.m.

JUBILEE BANQUET to which all members and friends of the commandery are invited will take place at 6:30 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 5 in St. Michael's Hall. Reception will precede the dinner at 6:15 p.m. A "Gonnet" and refreshments to follow the dinner. The High Mass of Thanksgiving will be celebrated Sunday, Oct. 6 at 8:30 a.m. in St. Michael's Church.

On Oct. 3, 1873, 20 young men of the then infant St. Michael's Church formed an organization called "St. George Camp of Supreme President's Staff and honored by Pope Pius XI as a Knight of St. Gregory.

In May, 1879, all unincorporated societies of the city were organized into the First Regiment Catholic Knights and were called "Roman Catholic Union Knights of St. John." In June, 1879 in Baltimore the "Roman Catholic Union Knights of St. John" was permanently organized on a national basis and the name of "St. George Ritter Verein" was changed to Knights of St. George.

The Knights of St. John was incorporated in the State of New York in 1884. The present

Confraternity Teacher Classes

The new fall program for beginners in the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine teacher-training course starts Monday evening, Sept. 30, at the Assumption School of Religion, 10 Baumer Place, Fairport.

The Confraternity course includes 30 hours of doctrine taught by diocesan priests, and by the Mission Helpers of the Sacred Heart, a community of nuns specially dedicated to the religious instruction of children.

Classes will meet Monday evening 7:30 to 9:30 p.m.

Those who complete the course will be eligible for certification and graduation next spring.

IN ADDITION to the beginner's course, a Scripture course is being offered to graduate catechists to begin Thursday, Oct. 17. Rev. William H. Shannon of Nazareth College will conduct this eight-week summer and eight weeks in spring series on Thursday also at 7:30 p.m. at the Fairport school.

Diocesan officials of the Confraternity program invite lay
