# Noonday Review Given On 'Searcher of Majesty'

"A book which is frequently thought-provoking and occasionally just provoking" was the reviewer's judgment on Solange Hertz' "SEARCHER OF MAJESTY."

"Not only knowledge, but love and appreciation of the inspired Word shine out on every page," she commented.

On the debit side, she listed these three points:

1. "Too much emphasis on woman's subordinate role in marriage."

2. "She's skeptical about the value of higher education for women."

3. "She pushes the idea of 'woman's place being in the home' to the extreme. For her, almost any outside activity would be interfering with woman's basic role—housewife."

Despite these demurs, Mrs. Shaughnessy's over-all judgment was favorable. For her, the author's lovely command of language, her witty play on words and her enthusiasm.

"Searcher of Majesty" is a symbolic title, with the soul of woman being "the searcher," and "Majesty" being a title for God.

"All in all, this book can be the occasion of many actual graces for the woman searching for God," concluded Mrs. Shaughnessy.
