Your Excellency,

The appalling news of the assassination of President Kennedy has shocked us all deeply. Everybody I have apoleen to shares with me the sense of a pernonal Loss in the death of this good man, I feel the urge to communicate with some one of his country, men our sympathy and sorrow and so I write to you to convey to you and your good people our prolound condolences in this tragic loss.

The news came just half an hour before I was due to say the evening Mass last night and so I offered a Requiem for the dead President. I am offering an other Requiem on Monday, the day of the funeral, at which the Mayor and Corporation of Rochester will be


