U.S. Youth, Red Target

FBI Chief Scores "Mollycoddling"

New York — (NC) — FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover, honored here by the Catholic youth of America, warned that "communists are engaged in an intensive campaign to control the minds and win the allegiance of American youth."

"During the past two years communist spokesmen have appeared on nearly 100 campuses from coast to coast," Hoover said after receiving the Pro Deo et Juventute (For God and Youth) Medal at the Nov. 18 convention of the Catholic Youth Organization Federation.

THE FBI CHIEF focused his attention on the menace posed by communism, but he also said that Americans are developing "a dangerously indulgent attitude toward pornography and have 'mollycoddled' young criminals."

Hoover said that in the Red effort to win over American youth "a national youth commission has been established within the Communist party. U.S.A.; special publications have been issued; front groups have been organized; and an ambitious speech program has been directed against our colleges and universities."

The purpose of the communist speaking campaign on campuses, he said, is "to create confusion, raise questions and spread doubts among young people concerning the American way of life."

"If their constitutional right to free speech allows them to

use the public school forum to promote the secular creed of Marxism-Leninism — which openly and avowedly denies God — does their constitutional freedom of religion also prohibit the rest of us from using the same public school forum to express our faith that God does exist?" he asked.

In referring to lawlessness and pornography, Hoover said "Americans, in growing numbers, are developing a dangerously indulgent attitude toward crime, filth and corruption."

"No one can deny that motion pictures are deliberately and definitely pursuing the same public school forum to express our faith that God does exist?" he asked.

"No one can deny that sexual trash is moving closer and closer to the children's books on the shelves of our newsstands and magazine stores."

"Our youth do not need weakness; they need strength. They do not need indulgence; they need the guidance and the discipline which can best be provided by a decent home."

"Above all," Hoover said, "they need the benefit of religion — in church, at home and in the atmosphere of our classrooms."

The FBI director, calling for a more realistic attitude toward the problem of crime, said "the charitable approach toward young hoodlums has been tried and found wanting."

"The bleeding hearts, some actually sworn to administer the law either as judges or social workers, are so concerned for young criminals and terrorists that they are indifferent to the rights of law-abiding members of society," he charged.

Hoover said the crime problem "costs the American people some \$22 billion a year, nine times the amount contributed to our churches," and "for every dollar spent on educating our children, \$11 goes to crime."

He said this country's "most 'avoidable weapons' against the challenges it faces are faith, individualism, courage, integrity, discipline and vision."

These qualities "are the keys to freedom," he concluded.

Philadelphia — (RNS) — Five Roman Catholic and five Jewish observers were in attendance for the first time of an official basis — at the sixth triennial General Assembly of the United National Council of Churches here, Dec. 1-7.

The presence of the observers highlighted a major concern of the approximately 4,000 clergy and laymen and women present from the NCC's 31 Protestant and Orthodox denominations: heightening the witness of the church through an expanded ecumenical approach.

In addition to attending business sessions, delegates were assigned to 120 different section meetings to explore local ecumenicity and the ministry of the laity in relation to race, peace with justice and freedom, technology and livelihood and faith and order.
