Pope Promises Prayers for U.S.-LBJ Meeting

WASHINGTON (AP) — Pope Paul VI promised to pray for the meeting between President Johnson and Soviet Premier Khrushchev.

The Pope responded to this request even before finishing reading his letter, the Peace Corps director pointed out.

When the pontiff reached the passage asking for prayers, Mr. Shriver related, he paused and quickly said he was not only willing to offer such prayers but was pleased at having been asked to do so.

Cardinal Attends Orthodox Rite

BOSTON (AP) — Archbishop Cardinal Coggiano, Archbishop of Boston, made a momentary visit here when he attended a Christmas Eve ceremony at the Russian Orthodox Church of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary.

The Catholic prelate attended the services upon the invitation of Archbishop Theodosius Herakleides of the Russian Orthodox Church. He was accompanied by Rev. Eugene Gravelle, his private secretary, and Father John Gauthier, his chaplain.

After the services, Archbishop Coggiano said, the president of the Argentinian Catholic Priests indicated the closer ties now existing between Roman Catholic and Orthodox Churches and the "possibility of Christian unity."

The Russian Orthodox church also stressed the importance of the Holy Land meetings of Pope Paul VI and Ecumenical Patriarch Athenagoras. The references, he said, had produced further evidence of better understanding between "brothers in religion."
