

Sue Warden To Compete At Saratoga

Sue Warden, 12-year-old Rochester speed skating star whose training was severely curtailed by a lengthy illness, will enter her first competition of the season this weekend when she participates in the Eastern States Championship held at Saratoga Jan. 11 and 12.

She won the event last year as well as numerous other contests including the National, North American, New York State and city championships.

Although the illness left Sue weak, her coach George Blackburn states that she will skate a limited schedule this year and "will definitely make her presence known." Although her training program was drastically reduced, Blackburn feels that she still has an excellent chance to defend some, if not all, of her titles.

The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. E. H. (Bud) Warden of 357 Ravenwood Ave., Sue attends Our Lady of Good Counsel School. She is a neighbor of Janice Smith, recently named to the U.S. Olympic Speed Skating team.

Blackburn added that Sue is a great competitor and one of the foremost skaters in her class in the country.

Wrestling Won By McQuaid

A come-from-behind victory in wrestling and a split-second loss in swimming highlighted the activity of McQuaid Jesuit High team on those fronts in the past week.

Dave Foley, a 155-pound junior pressed into service against an opponent some 50 pounds heavier came through with a pin in the unlimited division to climax a McQuaid rally that produced a 2-1 decision over Bishop Kearney last Saturday.

Joining Foley in contributing to the victory at Kearney were juniors Mark Hobson (180) and Doug Krenser (140), seniors Jim Conrad (160), Mike Gallagher (165), and Joe Gallagher (166), and freshmen Tim Boonker (114). Winners in a losing cause at Saratoga were sophomores Phil Reed (95), Jim Viscardi (123), Alek Mangione (129), and Doug Adelt (147), along with repeaters Quigley and Krenser.

Day Oberst, Tom Bailey and Phil Dollard of Kearney kept their winning streak going in dual meets as they all notched decision victories.

In swimming, the Knights saw two third-place points escape by a hand's length and dropped a point via disqualification as they went down to a 2-1 defeat before Canandaigua at the CIO pool last Saturday. Tuesday's loss to a powerful West squad was a bit easier to absorb, 53-45, even though it brought the season's mark to 2-3. Today's meet at Franklin should start the Knights on the road back to a possible 5-0 season, with 7 other foes left to face.

Senior Kevin Culhane, sophomore Dave Mullins, and freshman Pete Harman have been consistent winners for the Knights all season. Culhane and Mullins have spread their versatility over a half-dozen events while Harman has piled up a string of breaststroke triumphs. Against Canandaigua, all three took firsts, Culhane in the individual medley, Mullins in the butterfly and 200 free style, and Harman in his specialty.

Freshman Ed Murrer chipped in with a backstroke win and joined Harman, freshman John Odenbach, and Culhane on a winning medley relay. Sprinters John Sheehan, Larry Oakley, and John Warner—all seniors—along with Odenbach, Al Innes, and Dan Peisacher, gave the Knights 15 place points, leaving them just short of the magic 48 total needed for the win.

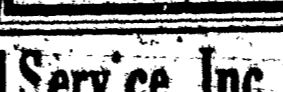
