

## Mother Solanus Dies, Former Local Superior

Mother M. Solanus, 65, of the Allegheny Franciscan Sisters died Feb. 3, 1964, at St. Elizabeth's Hospital, Ulfca after a brief illness. The former Della O'Donnell was born in Waterbury, Conn., and entered the Allegheny Sisterhood in 1916. She spent 48 years in religion, most of them as parochial school teacher and administrator. She was a beloved and kindly superior and principal, widely admired for her administrative skills, according to her associates.

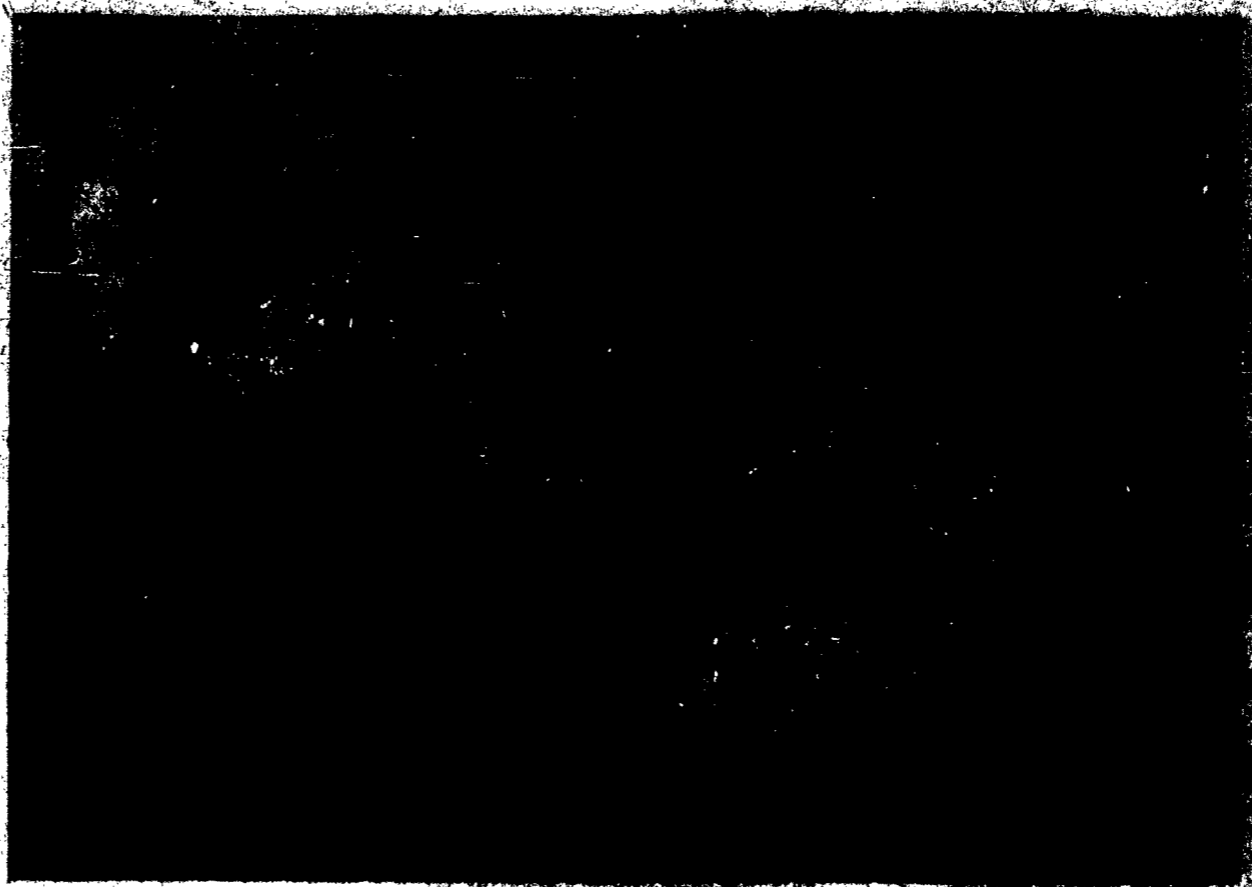

## Franciscan, Nazareth Grad To Receive Science Degree

Sister M. Paul Francis, OSF, the former Olivia Mariani of Rochester, will graduate from DePaul University, Chicago, on Sunday, Feb. 9 at the midwinter convocation ceremony, and will receive a Bachelor of Science degree in medical technology. Sister M. Paul Francis, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Paul Mariani, 28 Creekwood Dr., attended Holy Rosary Grammar School and Nazareth Academy. Before entrance into the Springfield Franciscan, as her community is commonly known, she attended Nazareth College for one year. SHE ENTERED the convent in August of 1937 and, after three years of preparation she pronounced her first vows in September, 1940. Sister attended DePaul University as a medical technology major and spent her year of internship at St. John's Hospital, Springfield, Ill. (a hospital operated by the Springfield Franciscans). In September of 1963 she graduated from St. John's Hospital School of medical technology and in November of that year she wrote her National Registry Examination. Presently Sister is working at St. Vincent's Hospital, Green Bay, Wis., a 300-bed hospital. The Springfield Franciscans, whose motherhouse is located in Springfield, Ill., operate hospitals, homes for the aged, homes for unwed mothers, do catechetical work and have missions in Japan and among the Indians in Lukachukia and China, Asia.
