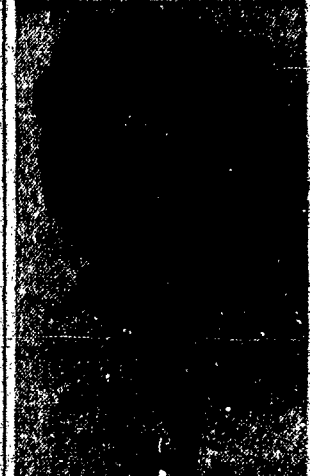




### Receive Scouting Awards

Pro-scouts are watching this college wizard who still has another year to play.

Youmans performed for the 1959 Championship Syracuse University eleven that featured Jimmy Brown, the Cleveland star who spoke at the SMS dinner in 1960. Like the featured speaker for this year's banquet, Dick Lynch of the New York football Giants, Youmans is a standout on defense.

Prior to Lynch's address, Durso will present the lodge award to the youth judged the "outstanding Athlete at Mynderse Academy," this past year.

At 4 p.m. Lynch will conduct a football clinic in the lodge rooms with a football to be given to one of the boys.
