A program of entertainment, featuring the talents of the school children, will be presented in the Parish Center on May 14, at 8 p. m.

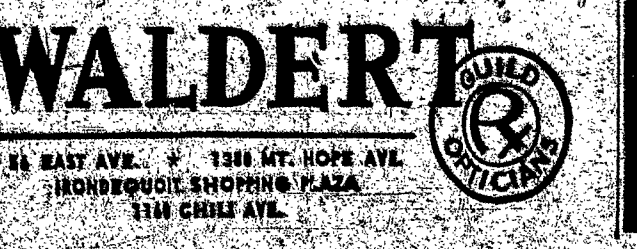
Bishop Kearney will preside and deliver the invocation. Mass will be at 8 a. m. at St. John's.

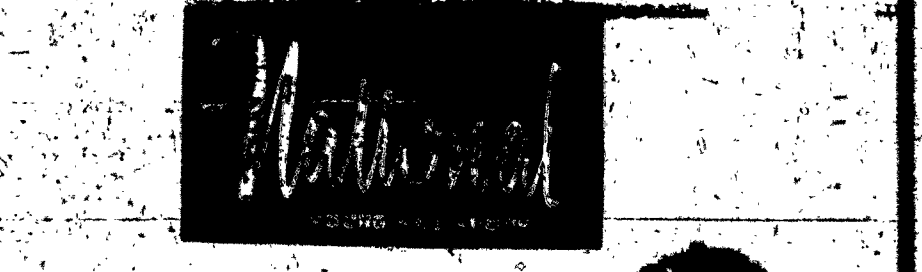
