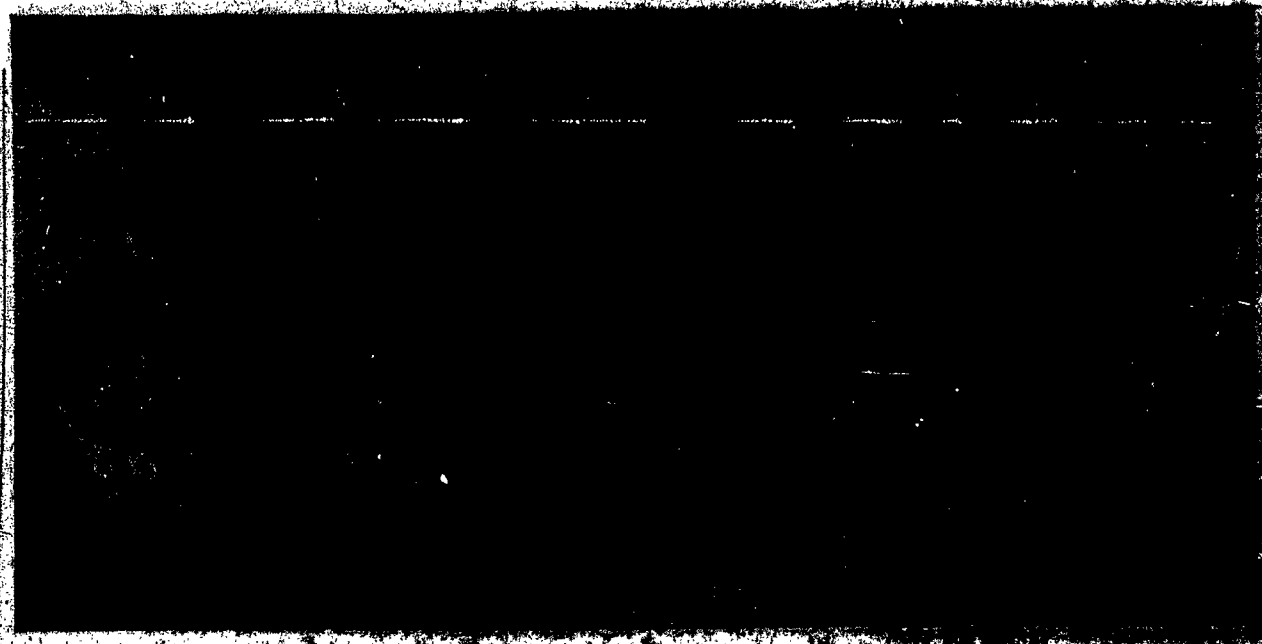

Colleges Announce Hike In Tuition

The presidents of Nazareth College of Rochester and St. John Fisher College this week announced increases in tuition for the 1964-65 academic year. The increases were outlined in separate letters to students and their parents.

The annual, two-semester tuition at Nazareth College will increase from \$800 to \$1,000. The increase will include laboratory and departmental fees which previously were separate charges. Room and meals at Nazareth College will increase from \$900 to \$980 a year.

Annual tuition at St. John Fisher College will increase from \$940 to \$1,150. There will be no change in charges for room and meals at Fisher.

Nazareth, a women's college with a registration of 800, and St. John Fisher College, a men's college with 700 students, cooperate in a program which enables both schools to share libraries, laboratories and other instructional and cultural facilities. According to Sister Helen Daniel, president of Nazareth, the tuition and residence increases are necessary "in order to maintain the quality of education that Nazareth has given over the years."

The Very Rev. Charles J. Lavery, C.S.B., president of St. John Fisher College stated that action to increase tuition "was taken reluctantly and following a comprehensive study conducted by the N. Y. State Higher Education Department . . . with the clear knowledge that tuition charges must reflect the steadily increasing costs of education. The new schedule was set at the absolute minimum necessary for the college to
