

Sue Warden, Coach Take Top Honors

Sue Warden, 12-year-old local speed skating star, won the Outstanding Skater Award last weekend at the Eastern Seaboard Speed Skating Championships in Pittsfield, Mass. in a meet with more than 250 entrants. Sue also took the Juvenile Girls crown by sweeping to first place in the 220, 330 and 440 yard races.

Rosemary Callipare, 7, also won a title by taking first place in the 110 and 220 yard events in the Pee Wee Girls class. She attends St. John's School in Greece and is the daughter of former city champion Tony Callipare. Two weeks ago she set a new record in the 220 yard event in the Canadian Championships at Barrie, Ontario with a time of 33.2.

Sue, who was a doubtful competitor this year due to a bout with infectious mononucleosis, has done well in winning 18 out of 19 races she has entered. She is a student at Good Counsel School and the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. E. H. (Bus) Warden.

Sue's coach, George Blackburn, was honored last week as the Sportsman of the Month by the Rochester Times-Union. Blackburn also coached Janice Smith prior to her entry in the 1984 Olympic Games in Austria.

Concerning the honor, Blackburn said "If I have been of any help to any of the children, that is my personal reward and I expect no bouquets for doing something that has brought me the greatest pleasure."

He added that "One of my greatest joys has been having a hand in seeing Sue Warden attain her present status as one of the foremost skaters in the country. Coaching Sue has been a most satisfactory experience."
