Population, Poverty Topics To Be Discussed

"Population Explosion and Poverty" will be discussed by a world expert at 8:15 p.m. Sunday, Mar. 15, at Nazareth College Auditorium. The public is invited, with no admission charge.

Speaker will be the Rev. Arthur McCormack, M.A., a Mill Hill Missioner from London, England.

Father McCormack's book, "World Poverty and the Christian," is one of the volumes in the "Twentieth Century Encyclopedia of Catholicism" now being compiled.

Formerly a missionary in West Africa, Father McCormack is co-editor of "World Justice," organ of the Research Centre for International Social Justice of Louvain University, Belgium. He is the author of "People, Space, Food," and editor of "Christian Responsibility and World Poverty," a symposium.

The English priest-author will be presented by the Rev. Raymond Kennedy of St. Andrew's Seminary faculty, chaplain of St. Joseph's House of Hospitality, sponsors of the lecture.
