

St. Josaphat Parish Construction To Begin

The contract for the construction of St. Josaphat's School was awarded to LeCesse Corp. of Rochester, according to Very Rev. Stephen A. Chomko, pastor of St. Josaphat's Parish. Construction of the \$480,000 elementary school, hall and cafeteria facilities is expected to start March 23.

The new facility is expected to be completed by July 1, 1968 and will be used for Masses until a permanent church is built.

NEW SCHOOL will be constructed on Ridge Road East and Stanton Lane in Irondequoit. It will be within a few blocks of Bishop Kearney High School.

The nine classroom building will be a one-story structure of fire-resistant construction. It will accommodate 400 pupils. The Multi-purpose hall will eventually be used for a gymnasium and auditorium and the lower hall beneath it will have eight bowling alleys. An adjoining building will contain the cafeteria accommodating 300 pupils where hot lunches will be served to enrolled school children.

The auditorium will be used for Sunday and Daily Masses. The school will include administrative offices and a library.

The Sister Servants of Mary Immaculate will staff the school. Design and architectural rendering of the new facilities were the work of Michael LaRosa, A.I.A., of Rochester.

Ground breaking ceremonies are scheduled for Sunday March 22nd at 4:00 p.m. at the corner of Ridge Road East and Stanton Lane. His Excellency
