

Mooney High School Scholarships Awarded

Catholic Editors To Hear Shriver

New York — (RNS) — Peace Corps Director Robert Sargent Shriver Jr., just named by President Johnson to head his anti-poverty campaign, will give the principal address at the 34th annual meeting of the Catholic Press Association in Pittsburgh, Pa., May 26-29.

Mr. Shriver's brother-in-law, has been selected to head the Office of Economic Opportunity which is expected to be created to carry out the \$1 billion war against poverty in this country in the midst of plenty.

Other main speakers and their topics are: Father Fredrick McManus of Catholic University of America, a liturgical expert for the Vatican Council, on "The Council, the Press and the Liturgy"; Father Eugene H. Maloy of St. Mary's Seminary, Cincinnati, an official theologian to the Council, on "The Council, the Press and Biblical Study"; and Father Gregory Baum, O.S.A. of St. Michael's College, University of Toronto, director of the Center of Ecumenical Studies at Toronto on "The Council, the Press and Ecumenism."
