

Mission Bouts Set For April 3 & 4

Five 1963 champs will be among the 44 finalists appearing on the annual Mission Bout card at Aquinas Institute on April 3 and 4 at 8 p.m. The bouts will be held in the school auditorium.

Seeking repeats of titles they won last year will be Jim Dentinger, Ron Becker, Vic Lynd, and Jerry Flynn.

Lynd is looking for the welterweight championship; Degnan the bantamweight title and Spillotti the middleweight title.

Friday night's card (April 3) is made up predominantly of freshmen. Saturday night 22 upperclassmen, including the five title holders, will vie for honors.
