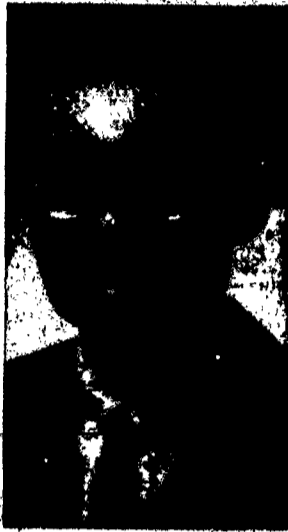


Aquinas Students Receive Awards

Two Aquinas Institute students have brought distinction to themselves and their school during the past week, one in the field of oratory, the other in science.

James Austin, son of Mr. and Mrs. Gerard Austin of St. Thomas the Apostle parish returned from Albany last Saturday with the coveted New York State Gavel Award, the highest individual award for school boy oratorical excellence in the state. The honor was conferred on Austin by the National Forensic League's Student Congress. In addition, he was unanimously chosen the Speaker of the House by the 150 delegates.
