Acquired by Monsignor Gerald Lambert, pastor, and valued at an estimated \$10,000, the plaque was carved by Florentine artist Antonio Rossellino. It has been put in place in the church baptistry, a gift of Russell J. Huebner of Philadelphia. The installation and a new altar were donated by Mr. and Mrs. Cecil Hill of Rochester.

Father Dollen Edits Work On Doctrine

The 283-page book is lavishly illustrated. Translations were made by scholars from the Catholic University of America press, as well as by Father Dollen. The third book produced by Father Dollen, the first being "The Divine Cosmos Bibliography," is also the author of the recent pamphlet, "Toward Responsible Parenthood on the rhythm method of natural birth control."

Both the hardback and paperback editions of the new publication were released by the publisher, St. Paul Editions.

Designed as a companion piece to "A Voice Said Aye" published last year, the new volume looks at the doctrine of the Divinity of Christ as understood by the writers in the early centuries of Christianity. The title is taken from St. Paul's first epistle to the Corinthians: "No one can say Jesus's Lord" except in the Holy
