**Miss Manley Requiem Held Priest's Kin**

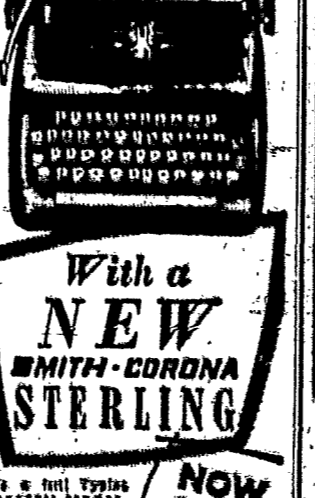

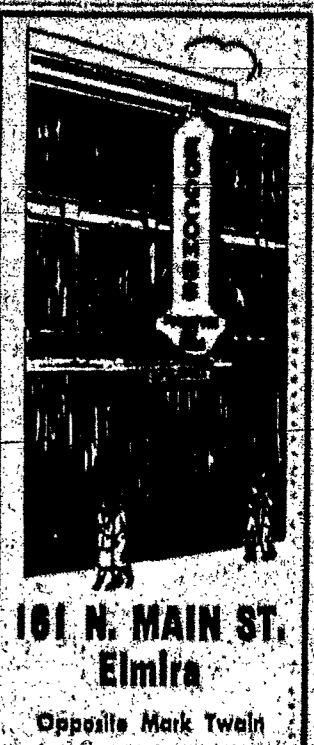
