

Father Prendergast Marks Silver Jubilee

Father Harold P. Prendergast, a former Rochesterian, celebrated the 25th anniversary of his ordination recently in his present parish, Immaculate Conception, Monmouth, Ill.

Father Prendergast attended Sacred Heart Grammar School, Aquinas Institute, Rochester Business Institute, St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's Seminaries in Rochester. He took his theology at St. Bonaventure University.

Ordained May 18, 1939 in Erie, Pa., his first assignment as assistant pastor in Peoria, Ill. He was transferred to Lincoln, Ill. in 1940 and in 1949 was appointed pastor of St. Patrick's Church, Camp Grove, Ill. by Archbishop Schlueman.

In 1958 he was appointed Pro-Synodal Judge of the Diocese of Peoria. In 1960 was named pastor of Immaculate Conception Church, Monmouth, Ill. In 1962 at the Diocesan Synod, he was named Synodal Judge. He was named Deanery Chaplain of the Legion of Mary and a member of the Board of directors of the Diocesan Clergy Aid Society in 1964.

Father Prendergast celebrated a Solemn Mass of Thanks

giving on June 1 to mark his silver sacerdotal jubilee with more than 100 priests of his diocese taking part.

He is the son of Mrs. Frank Prendergast and the late Mr. Frank Prendergast who lived most of their lives in Sacred Heart Parish, here. He has two sisters, Mrs. Leo F. Flynn and Mrs. Walter Zehder and one brother, George Prendergast, all of Rochester.

Rev. John Philipps assisted Father McManus at the grave in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery. Arrangements by John M. Hedges Funeral Home.

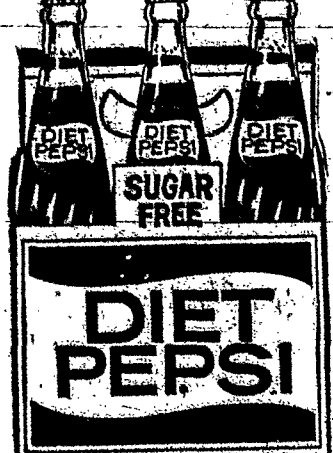
