Cardinal Asks Prayers For Orthodox

Munich, (RNS)—Apostolic Cardinal Döpfner has appealed to all Christians to pray for the Orthodox Patriarchate of Constantinople and for all Orthodox Churches which are undergoing persecution. Speaking in the Cathedral of Our Lady here on Pentecost (May 17), the Archbishop of Munich and Freising declared: "The danger that Patriarch Athenagoras (of Constantinople) will be expelled from the country by the Turkish government has not been precluded. In the love of the Holy Spirit we feel fraternal sympathy with Athenagoras, who despite the supernatural character of the patriarchate has been caught up in the political tensions arising between Greece and Turkey because of the Cyprus conflict."

Halt Programs Against Jews

New York — (RNS) — Two thousand Protestant and Catholic clergy leaders signed a "Letter of Conscience" in Russia, appealing for an end to the persecution of some 3,000,000 Jews in the Soviet Union.

The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith, Jewish human relations agency which sponsored the appeal, said the petition will be forwarded to the State Department and United Nations for transmission to Premier Nikita Khrushchev of Russia.

TEXT OF THE letter and names of its signers were released here by Label A. Katz, president of B'nai B'rith, and Dore Schary, chairman of the ADL.

Signers included three Catholic cardinals and 19 archbishops and bishops, 17 presidents of Catholic colleges and universities, a number of Protestant Episcopal and Methodist bishops and officers of other Protestant denominations, and ten presidents and deans of Protestant colleges.

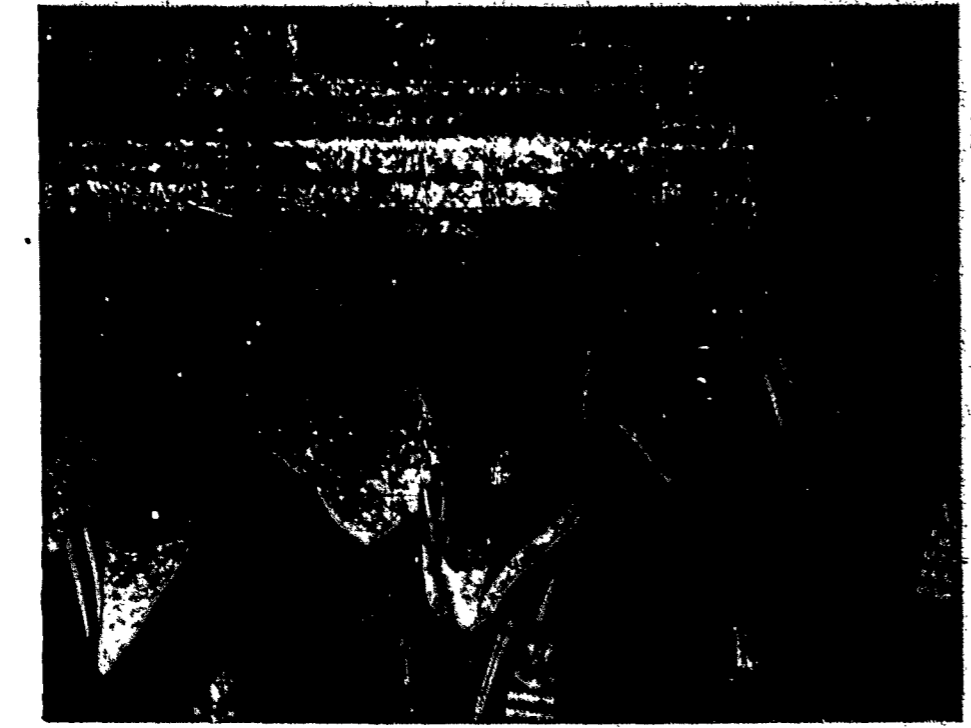

The commission was established five years ago to combat by legal means what it claimed were "repressive acts by government authorities."

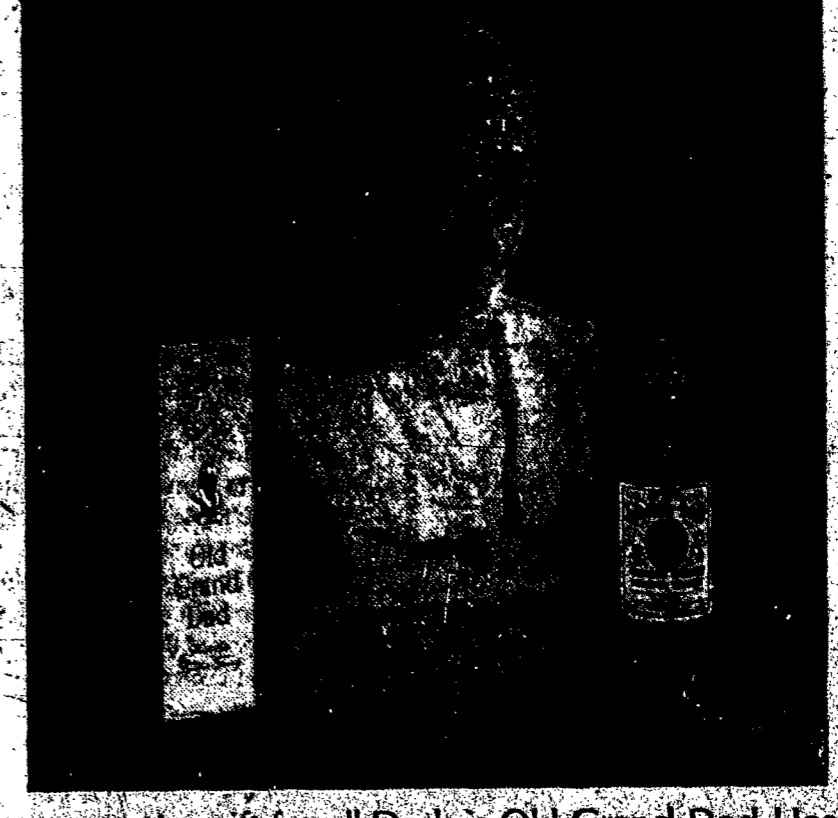
