Seminary Rectors Study Church's New Liturgy
Detroit—(N.C.)—About 150 seminary rectors or their representatives will meet here June 18 and 19 to discuss the application of the Vatican council's Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy to seminary education.
The meeting was called by Archbishop John F. Dargatzis of Detroit in his capacity as chairman of the Bishops' Commission on the Liturgical Apostolate.
The discussion will be centered on three areas: Liturgical courses, Liturgical formation of the spiritual life, and Liturgical courses such as dogma and integration in other seminary Scripture.
