

Carmelite, Fr. Marianus Marks 25 Years As Priest

Auburn—Father Marianus Novakowski, O. Carm., who, for nearly ten years, worked with Catholics of Auburn and its surrounding areas, celebrated his 25th anniversary as a priest this Sunday, June 21, at Our Lady of the Scapular Church, New York City.

A native of Poland, Father Marianus is best remembered for the two shrines he erected in this area, in thanksgiving to the Blessed Virgin for having been saved three times from possible execution in German concentration camps during the Nazi regime. The two shrines, constructed by hand from field stones, stand in Skaneateles and on the grounds of the Carmelite monastery on South St.

Following preparatory studies in Krakow, Poland, Father Marianus was ordained a priest in June of 1939, just prior to World War II. After his first Mass in his hometown of Lwow, he left his family, never to return there to this day.

As war came, Father Marianus entered the service, working among the soldiers as a mobilized chaplain. During the Nazi occupation, he was imprisoned for five years at Krakow, as well as Auschwitz and Dachau concentration camps.

Following his rescue, Father Marianus worked as a chaplain and nurse for the other freed inmates who were sick and homeless. In 1945, he was made chaplain at a displaced persons camp. This included the task of organizing and teaching in the camp's school, and supervising the hospital and prison institutions. During this period, he was also editor of "The Dove of Freedom," a post-war journal, and served as an active member of the National Catholic Welfare Commission, N.C.W.C., instrumental in helping many find new homes abroad.

In 1950, Father Marianus came to the United States, and, due to his deep devotion to Our Lady, joined the Carmelite order. After a brief stay in Fairport and Middletown, N.Y., outside New York City, he was sent to Auburn where he worked as an assistant pastor at St. Alphonsus Church until 1950. He has become known to countless Auburnians as a favorite confessor, spiritual advisor and chaplain to the sick. When Mount Carmel High School opened in 1955, Father Marianus worked there as a spiritual director to Carmel students, occasionally hearing confessions and discussing their problems. Said one former student recalling him, "Father Marianus always had time for

some kind word or bit of helpful advice.

Father Marianus said his last Mass at St. Alphonsus in August of 1960, and left for New York City where he took a position on the staff of chaplains to Bellevue Hospital, the city's largest and busiest.

Aided by his fluent command of several languages and his amiable personality, he still works in this role.

In a telephone interview with the Rev. Marianus Tuesday, he expressed his intentions of returning to Auburn for a visit in July or August to see old friends. "I would also like to say one more Mass at St. Alphonsus where I spent a long time on duty," he added.
