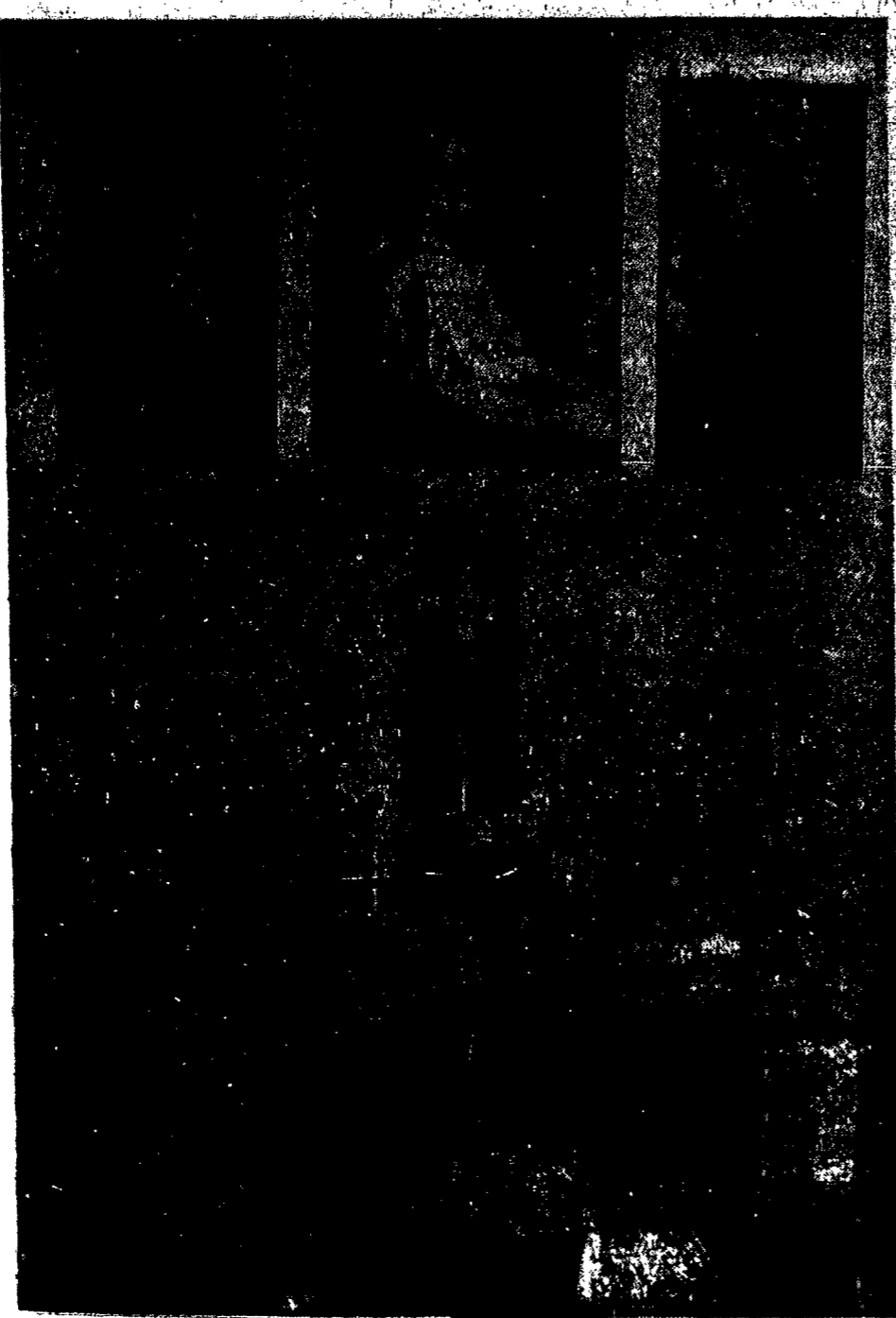
Registration for Legionaries of other dioceses will be taken at the Shrine entrance immediately before the procession. Private arrangements locally to be made by each parish. Father Marini said.

### Pieta at Paddy Hill Church

More than three million people have viewed Michaelangelo's famed Pieta at the World's Fair Vatican Pavilion . . . and just about that same number have knelt before the Pieta at Mother of Sorrows Church in the Town of Greece — in the 103 years it has been enshrined over the historic church's main altar. The picture was painted by Cardinal Cajetan Bodini of Rome and blessed and put in place by Bishop John Timon of Buffalo on July 2, 1851. Father Daniel O'Rourke was once offered \$5,000 for the painting but turned the offer down. Father George Wood, pastor, says "Those who want to avoid the crowds at the New York Fair can come to Paddy Hill and see our Pieta."
