An "Oscar" for the best motion picture performance in 1963 by an actor went to Sidney Politier, shown here in his award-winning role in the film, "Liles of the Field." The movie, based on a short novel by William E. Barrett, has an interreligous, interracial theme and has won wide critical acclaim. Politier, who commented in accepting his Academy Award at Los Angeles that it had been a "long journey to this moment," became the first Negro to win an Oscar in the top acting category. The movie's story is of a Negro Protestant ex-GI who helps a group of German nuns build a chapel in the Arizona desert. At top left, he debates Biblical references with the mother superior, played by Austrian-born actress, Lilia Skala.
