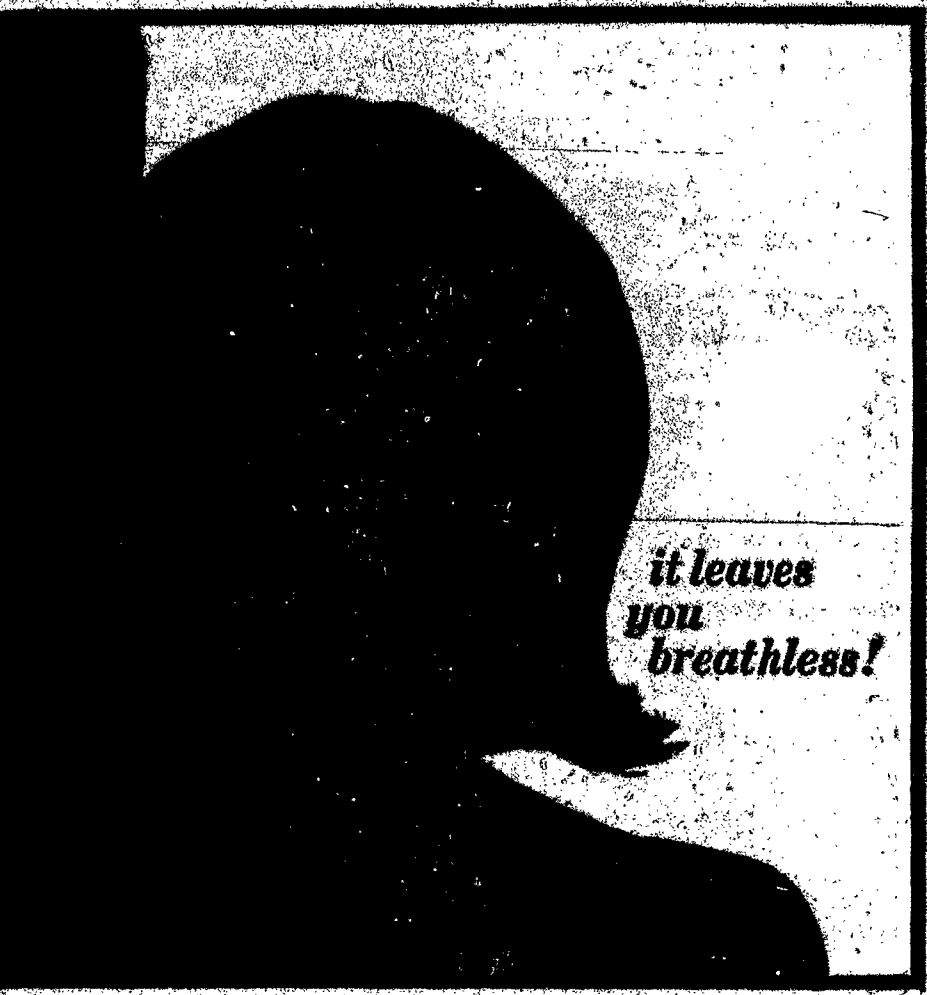

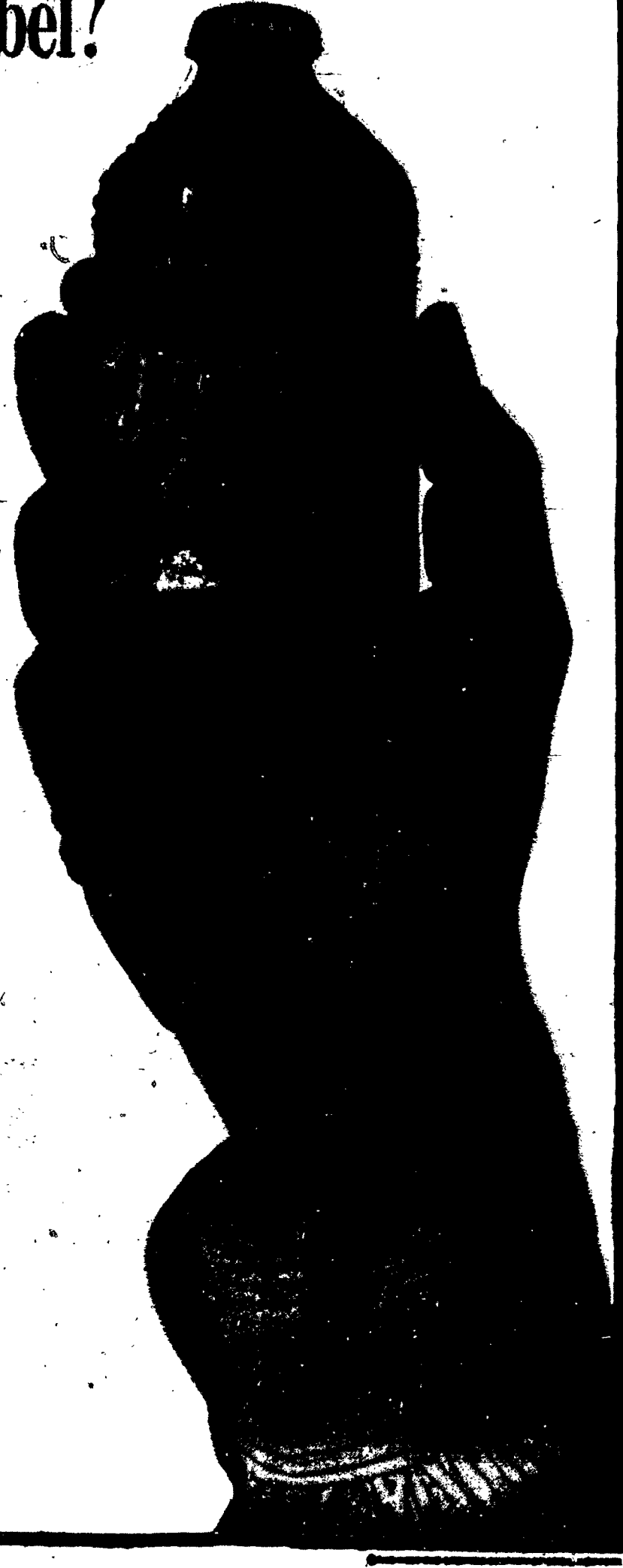

FARMINGDALE CITY (RNS)—Catholic parents in a working class district here will be spared the expense of buying special clothing for their children's first Holy Communion.

Archbishop Thomas A. Clavel of Farmingdale has ordered the students of ten schools in Santa Ana borough to receive Communion in their school uniforms.

The custom has been the girls to wear long white gowns with veils and crowns, and for the boys to wear white or navy blue suits.

Thousands of children, seven and eight years old, receive their first Holy Communion each year on Dec. 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception which is also celebrated here as Mother's Day.
