Hummel "Children" — Legacy to a Convent

"Hummel" figurines are the world's best loved children — and every time a "Hummel" child is adopted into a home or added to a collection the convent of Slessen receives a tiny gift to help it carry on its charitable work.

THE STORY is interesting and goes back to a little Bavarian girl who loved to sketch and write. Berta Hummel was born in Southern Bavaria, one of six children, into a family where music and art were part of her daily life.

Artistically precocious, she painted delightful little cards and wrote verse and was encouraged in this by both her parents and teachers. She continued to sketch the world around her — animals, flowers, her friends and at 18 she started her formal art education at the Academy of Fine Arts in Munich where she mastered the theory and the methods of art.

Always a religious child, her friendship for two Franciscan Sisters, who also attended the Academy of Art, was a turning point in her life. Through the Sisters she realized her life would not be complete unless she could combine both her love of art and her love for her fellow man.

Her desire to be of service to dedicate her talent for the benefit of mankind led her to follow her Sisters on the road to God and her first step was to become a novice of the Franciscan Order. She took her final vows as Sister M. Innocentia on August 30, 1934 in the Convent of Slessen, near Salzburg.

John McVeigh Funeral Mass Sung By Brother
