Marie received her bachelor of arts degree from St. Bonaventure University. She also pursued advanced studies at Marguerite Bourgeoys College and Loyola University in Quebec. Sister has been at Notre Dame since 1955.

Sister Mary James Edward will teach bookkeeping and general mathematics, and will be guidance counselor for the sophomore class. Sister holds a bachelor of science degree with a major in business from Nazareth College and has been on the staff at Notre Dame since 1960.

Sister Mary Jane Frances will continue to teach earth science and biology. A graduate of Nazareth College, she holds a master's degree from Syracuse University. Sister Jane Frances, who has been at Notre Dame since 1955, will continue as moderator of the Sodality.

Sister Mary Jeanine, chairman of the art department, will teach Art 1, 2, 3, 4 and mechanical drawing. She has taken a trip to Europe, which included tours of many major religious structures such as Lourdes, France, St. Peter's in Rome, and the original Motherhouse of the Sisters of Mercy in Dublin, Ireland.
