### School Opening Set In Corning Parishes

Corning — St. Mary's School of Corning will have about five more students than last year, according to the estimate for the September opening, made by Sister M. Bernard, who is principal of the school.

Anticipated enrollment at the beginning of the term is 312. The eight-member faculty will have one change. Sister Marie Anthony is coming here from Auburn to teach sixth grade. She is replacing Sister Marie Thomas, who is going to St. Rita's at West Webster.

The school will have a new audio-visual room this year. At the end of May an empty classroom was equipped with a motion picture screen and television reception facilities, the principal said. It will be available to students of the entire school.

The interior of St. Vincent de Paul's School has been entirely renovated in preparation for the resumption of classes on Sept. 9.

The work has been done by professional workmen, it was reported.

The school, whose enrollment is already at capacity, expects about the same number of students this fall as a year ago, when the total was about 400.

A slight falling off in the total pupil enrollment at St. Patrick's School is looked for.
