Arabi, La.—(NC)—Parishioners of St. Robert Bellarmine church here are without a church of their own but they're mighty proud of their chalice. It's inscribed, "In memory of John Fitzgerald Kennedy, 1917-1963—a gift from his brother, Atty. Gen. Robert F. Kennedy."
