**Schools Bulge in England**

LONDON — (NC) — The British government is reported to be considering further aid for Catholic schools now facing a population crisis in England and Wales.

Government officials met with the Bishops following the latest official estimate of an increase in the school population of 50 per cent by 1970.

The new estimate places Catholic education in an increasingly difficult position. Without more substantial aid the whole structure of state-subsidized Catholic schools inside the state system may collapse.

The Italian prelate was accompanied by Michael Cardinal Brown, O.P., of the Roman curia, a native of Ireland.

**Jesuit Raps Court Critics**

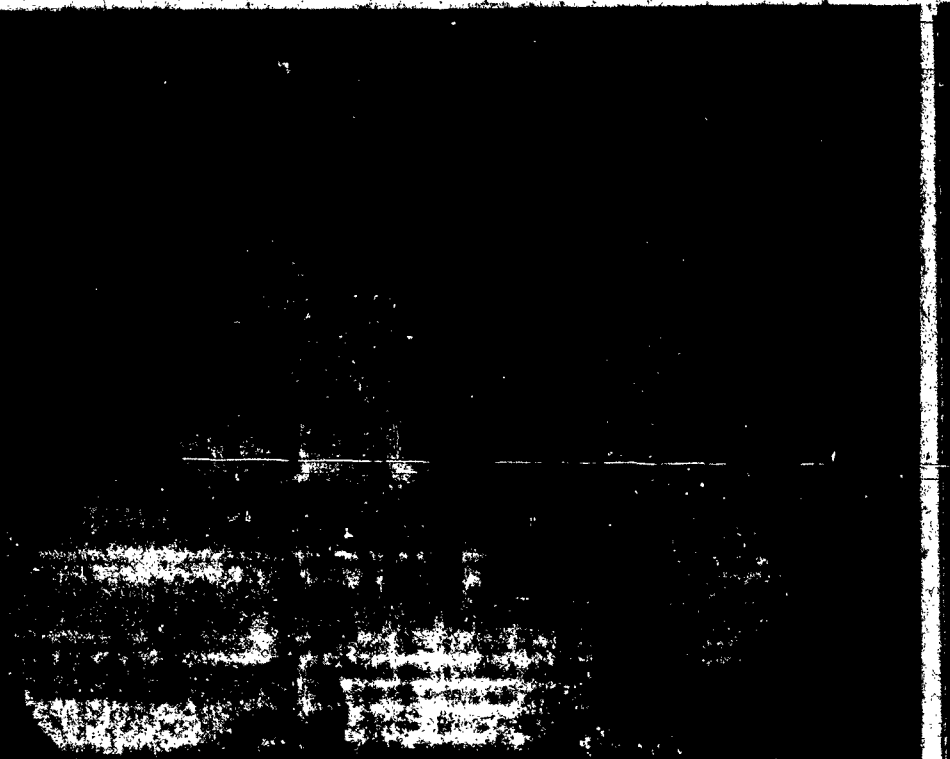
Bridgeport — (RNS) — A noted Jesuit legal expert has condemned some criticism of the U.S. Supreme Court as "intemperate, abusive, discourteous and truly un-Christian" in its opposition to the Court's rulings on religious exercises in public schools.

Father Robert F. Drinan, S.J., dean of Boston College's law school, told judges and lawyers attending the annual Red Mass in St. Augustine's Cathedral here that "the admittedly delicate and sensitive issues involved in church-state disputes should be forwarded every-where that he, above all others, has the responsibility and the obligation to bring calm, reason and dispassionate analysis into the continuing great national debate about the place of religion in education."

Bishop Walter W. Curtis of Bridgeport presided at the Mass which was sponsored by the St. Thomas More Society, an organization of Catholic laymen.

FATHER DRINAN said that because of two recent Supreme Court decisions, the nation's 45 million public school pupils must not, while in school, participate in religious practices of a devotional nature. At the same time, he said, "the staunchest of American traditions" require that the public schools must implant "high standards of morality and citizenship."

He called on jurists to do their part in helping the community to preserve and promote the

**University Cracks Down On Malaysia Red Pupils**

Singapore — (NC) — The government of Malaysia is taking strong action against communist activities in Nanyang University.

A three-man committee unanimously recommended deprivation of citizenship, saying "the committee are unanimous in their view that Mr. Tan Lark Sze had been engaged in activities prejudicial to the security of Malaysia and to the maintenance of public order therein."

The committee said that Tan Lark Sze, one of the founders of the nine-year-old university, had not originated any action of his own, "yet his appropriation, his failure to curb activities of both the undergraduates and some graduates on the staff of the university, were hostile and adverse to the security of the country."

At the time of Tan's resignation as chairman of the university, the committee said the university "was a grave security problem to Malaysia."

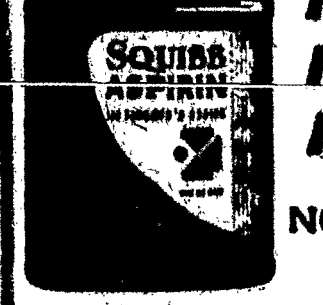
