Ecumenical Action To Be Stepped Up
Philadelphia — (NC) — Archbishop John J. Krol has called for stepped up efforts by Catholics in the ecumenical movement and outlined a program of action for the Philadelphia archdiocese.

The Archbishop, in a letter to priests of the archdiocese, said he was putting the archdiocesan ecumenical program under the Commission on Human Relations established last June. He urged that Catholics engage in prayer, study and action to increase their effectiveness in ecumenism.

Archbishop Krol said ecumenism is "an authentic impetus of the Holy Spirit" and noted that it has been strongly endorsed by Pope Paul VI.

"As usual," he commented, "the timorous regard it with distrust and the zealous try to push it beyond its proper dimensions. Correctly understood, the goal of ecumenism is the goal of the Church's mission to unite the human race in Christ."
