

## Dietetic Group Names Mercy's Sister M. Patrick

Sister Mary Patrick of the Rochester Sisters of Mercy has been admitted to the American Dietetic Association. It was announced in Boston recently. A certificate of membership in the national group was awarded to Sister upon her completion of the Post-Graduate Year of Dietetic Internship at Massachusetts General Hospital.

DIETETIC internship in the thousand-bed hospital is composed of weekly lectures and daily practice in the responsibilities of medical nutrition. Massachusetts General, the third oldest hospital in the United States, is the teaching hospital of Harvard Medical School.

Sister Mary Patrick, the daughter of Mrs. Frank Kennedy of Harper St., and the late Mr. John the Evangelist School. Having studied nutrition at Cornell University, she received her B.S. in Home Economics (Nutrition) from Columbia University. She has taught for several years on the faculties of Our Lady of Mercy High School and Notre Dame High School, Elmira.

This September Sister Mary Patrick will take up new duties as Chief Dietitian of St. James Mercy Hospital in Hornell, administered by the Sisters of Mercy. Sister's devotion to the field of hospital dietetics, she claims, "the result of the unusual inspiration accorded by the State of Massachusetts General Hospital, an institution outstandingly dedicated to the care and recovery of the sick."

Commenting on her experience at the Hospital, Sister said that its Director, Doctor John Knowles, formerly of the faculty of the University of Rochester Medical School, represents the entire personnel of the hospital in his conviction that "unless one works from a spiritual motive one cannot properly care for the sick."
