ing \$75,000 last year and it was our biggest year so far. At the camp at Herrington Lake for underprivileged boys we averaged 50 persons a day for four weeks. We had volunteers from eight colleges and one weekend had to feed 44 people.

"We don't know how much money we'll need next year if we set down and figured it out we'd quit," the priest concluded more dramatically than factually. "We go from week to week."

Father Belting said he wished wealthier parishes would adopt poorer ones — such as St. William's in Lancaster or St. Clare's in Berea or St. Paul's in McKee.

"My gripe is that the Church has become parochial — it should be interested in Catholics everywhere."

The 13 young women and four young men from the Boston area who worked in the fields and trudged through salmon-colored dust from August 31st to September 13th in eastern Kentucky were the last to go down this summer. They are part of a "young apostolate" begun by Father J. Joseph Kierce, assistant at St. Kevin's in Dorchester, Massachusetts.

Approximately 100 persons this summer and a dozen last summer visited various parts of the South and Border States, where there are few priests and poor parishes. The volunteers may build a mile, pick apples, interview residents to create goodwill for the Church, give a variety show for shy mountain children or stamp thousands of envelopes.

This exodus of volunteers from Boston was previously named the Catholic Peace Corps but this year they are called the "young apostolate," said Father Kierce. He is the advisor to groups in the archdiocese and to the Catholic Youth Organization, and Chi Rho, the young adults group.

"There isn't anything like it," he said of the volunteer movement. "We'll be sending down more people next year."

Father Kierce, who has spent his past summer vacations in Kentucky, has decided that "the way to get volunteers in to go yourself. Until the Church gets into the social action field, it will never touch these people."

"Invariably, all the volunteers who've gone down have told me it was the greatest experience of their lives." Father organizes work groups wherever there is a need for them. Bostonians have worked in West Virginia, western and eastern Kentucky and Alabama for priests who have heard of the recruiting program of the young Dorchester priest.

Father Kierce believes that most people cannot afford to take a year or two out of their work lives, working and residing in a poorer parish for board, room and maybe \$35 or \$50 a month. Therefore, he sends down seminarians, telephone operators, college girls and boys, office workers, life guards,

physicists and other assorted Catholics for work periods of two and three weeks.

"You got us out of a terrible hole, but you've got to do a lot more than you've done, a lot more."

In his book, Caudill has more to say on religion in the mountains, and is perhaps too pessimistic for the dynamic Father Belting.

"The Roman Catholic church has quietly sponsored long range programs of proselytizing in the region and is attempting the incredibly difficult task of recruiting a priesthood from the native stock."

"The obstacles such an undertaking must overcome are legion and significant headway may require a century. It can scarcely be doubted, however, that since every society leans heavily upon its spiritual advisors, be they witch doctors, parish priests or reverend ministers, the mountaineer will approach more closely the
