

'Truthfulness' to Prevail

By FATHER PLACID JORDAN, O. S. B. ROME—(NC)—"The Vatican Council has embarked on the right road by seeking to make truthfulness prevail in theology and in the Church generally to a greater extent than ever before," said Father Hans Kueng.

The Swiss theologian was addressing an overflowed audience at the Netherlands Documentation Center here, including numerous bishops. At the end of his lecture he was given a standing ovation.

As a Council expert, Father Kueng is on temporary leave from Tuebingen University in Germany, where he is a member of the faculty of Catholic theology and director of the ecumenical institute.

"The urge for truth," Father Kueng said, "is a distinctive aspect of contemporary cultural life. Authority as such is not accepted unless based on genuine values, and unless the truth that is preached is also lived. This is why Pope John XXIII met with so strong a response, especially on the part of the younger generation."

In the Church, too, the speaker said the "fortress mentality" characteristic of the period since the Protestant Reformation no longer prevails. "Triumphalism" is being replaced by a theology of the Cross for it is realized that the Church is a community of sinful men who often fail in their duties and are likely to make mistakes. (Triumphalism might be defined as a presumptuous attitude of Catholic supremacy, excusing Church leaders from a realistic approach to problems.)

Father Kueng pointed out that in the past, moral theology included among the cardinal especially neglected virtues truthfulness — it was not even

virtue. The 55th Commandment was overemphasized and the Eighth Commandment neglected, he said. This attitude also was reflected in biblical studies, he continued.

It is time, said the speaker, that we be honest and admit that we are not as infallible as we so often pretend to be. Now that the Church is officially seeking a dialogue with the modern world, she thereby acknowledges that she has long lived a life too far apart from modern progress in virtually all fields of human endeavor, Father Kueng stated.

He added that as a result there was widespread desertion of the faith, and many Catholics, because of reservations in their conscience, became "emigrants" when they could not reconcile the teachings of the Church with the requirements of an age that had made antiquated standards futile.

We now must restore the kind of veracity, said Father Kueng, which Our Lord preached when he condemned all hypocrisy and dishonesty. We must give up all pretense of a superficial, ritualistic and legalistic piety based on the letter
