Mary F. Lintz Rites Conducted

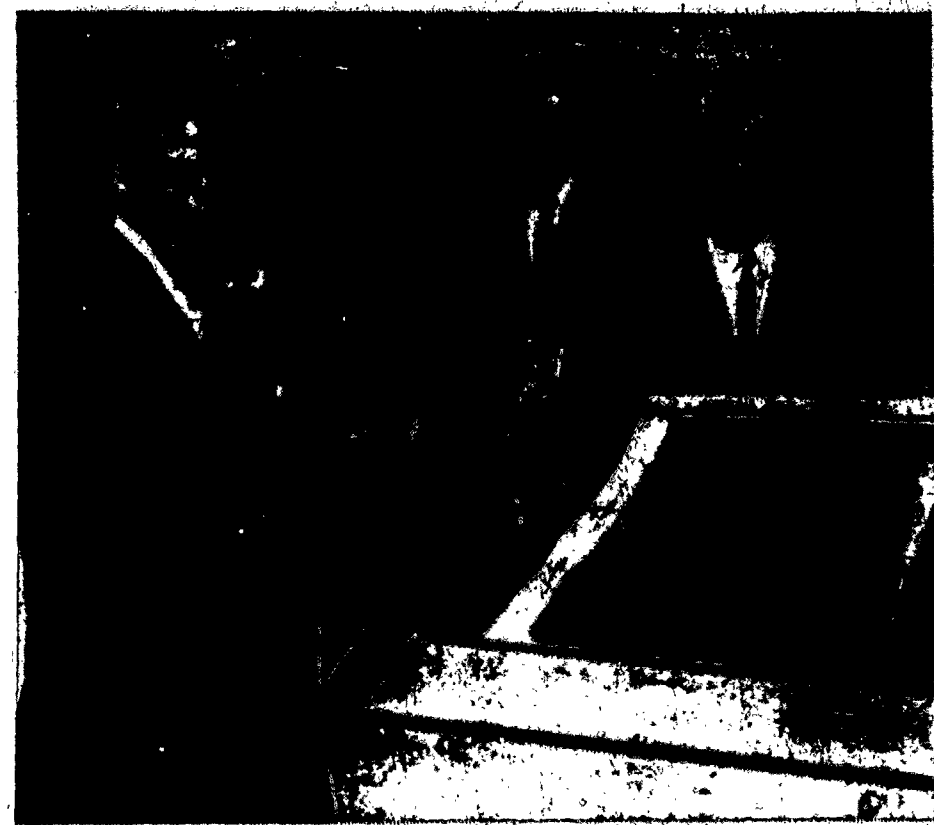
