

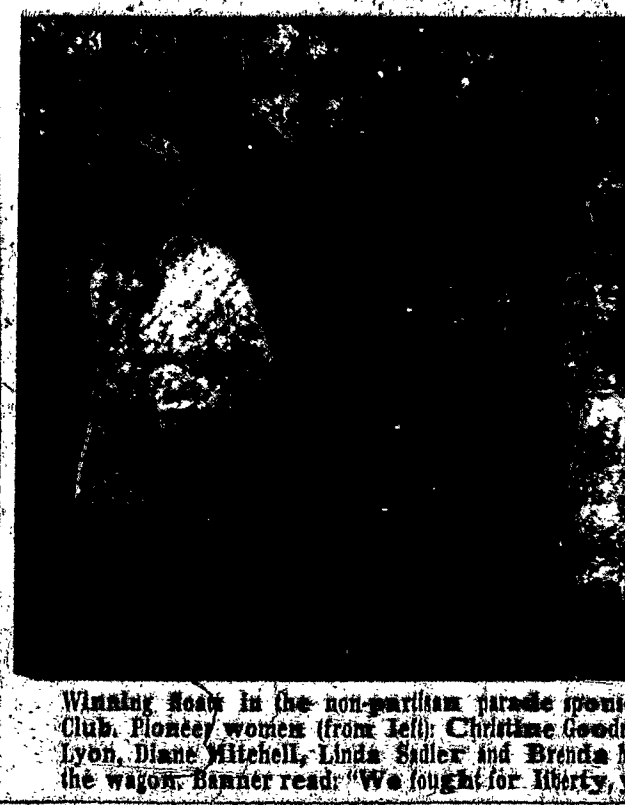
A Parade For Votes
