Aquinas Wins at RIT
Aquinas debaters won three trophies at the Fourth Annual Rochester Institute of Technology Debate Tournament held Nov. 7, 8.

Debate control of nuclear weapons by an international organization and facing power matching (winning debate teams against winning debate teams) the Aquinas "A" team won eight and lost two debates.

In taking second place the negative team of Senior Robert Craig and Junior David Hill went undefeated. The affirmative team of Thomas Farrell and James Hendrick broke their winning streak at twenty-one victories this school year as they dropped two debates.

The Aquinas "B" team also posted an eight win and two loss record as they faced Bishop Colton Girls High School in the final round. In losing to Colton the Aquinas team allowed them to take first place with a nine win, one loss record. The team is composed of Juniors Martin Drilling and Mark Killenbeck affirmatives; Ronald Hoening and Walter Kopinski negatives.

Two Speaker Awards were given to local students: David Hill of Aquinas was awarded Best Negative Speaker while Gregory Wroblewski of Bishop Kearney was awarded Third Best Negative Speaker.

Other local Catholic high schools to attend and their records were: Kearney "A" 6-4; Kearney "B" 4-6; Mooney 6-4; McQuaid "A" 6-4; McQuaid "B" 2-8.

Mooney Paces RADL
The first meeting of the Rochester Area Debate League found Cardinal Mooney High School taking second place in both the JV and Novice divisions. After four rounds of round robin debate at Aquinas Institute, on Oct. 31 the Novice Mooney team had compiled a six win and two loss record. An Aquinas team was awarded a third place tie with Irondequoit and Jefferson as they each posted records of five wins and three losses. Victor leads the Novice Division while Eastridge leads the JV division. The second of five meetings in the RADL will be held November 21 at McQuaid.
