Archbishops and Bishops of the United States meeting in Washington called upon the faithful to emulate Pope Pius XII in his program for peace and to remain calm in the world crisis.

Newly elected Supreme Secretary of the Knights of Columbus, Joseph F. Lamb was to be guest at the Annual Communion of Rochester Council in Columbus Civic Center and at the breakfast in Hotel Sagamore. Bishop Kearney was to celebrate the Mass at a special altar in the center.

State President Richard Hemmerlein of Syracuse, praised the Rochester branch, Catholic Central Verlen of America for cooperation in diocesan campaign for clean reading.
