ToyMaker Nun Dies in Omaha

Omaha — (NC) — The "toy-maker nun" of Duschekne College is dead.

Mother Bernadette McVeigh, 88, died in an Omaha hospital after a three-week illness. Funeral rites were conducted (Nov. 10) in the chapel of the women's college conducted here by the Religious of the Sacred Heart which she joined in 1898. She served in the community schools in Philadelphia, New York, Chicago, Lake Forest, Ill., San Francisco, Seattle, St. Joseph, Mo., and came to Duchesne in 1920.

She became known as the "toy-maker nun" as a result of stuffed toys she made for children. She won national recognition several times in recent years for her unusual toy-making

Seminarians From Abroad

Washington — (NC) — More than 3,000 seminarians from foreign countries are studying in 105 seminaries in the U.S. this year, a survey has disclosed.

The Foreign Visitors Office National Catholic Welfare Conference said 68 seminaries, responding to a questionnaire it distributed, reported 919 seminarians from foreign countries. Another 37 seminaries, reporting 122 foreign seminarians, were included in the annual foreign census of the Institute of International Education, hosting the total to 1,041.

Mexico accounted for nearly half the foreign seminarians with 413 students at the Montezuma (N.M.) Seminary. Next came the Philippines, 86 Canada, 61 Italy, 37, Brazil, 34, Spain, 17, Cuba, 15 and 14 each from India, Ireland and Germany.
