"Christmas Gifts for the Whole Family" is the theme of the Sisters of Mercy Christmas Sale, to be held Friday afternoon and evening, Dec. 4, in Mercy High School gym.

The annual Christmas bazaar is sponsored by the Mercy Guild; Mrs. Henry Kearse, chairman, invites the public to attend. Proceeds will benefit the diocesan Sisters of Mercy, according to Mother Mary Brude, Mother General, and Mrs. Walter B. Hickey, president of the Mercy Guild.

A MODERN ART motif will festoon the Christmas booth. Christmas holiday decorations, cribs, trees, centerpieces, candles, wreaths, place-mats, trays, fruit baskets, etc. are all stylized with a modern touch.

Like much of the work featured at the Christmas sale the greater part of the Christmas decorations are handmade, executed by the artistically inclined members of the Mercy Guild and community. Many of them have been at work for months preparing novelties.

Miniature Christmas trees made of pastel gaily net are resplendent with colorful ornaments, as are the more natural-looking ones made of pine cones and holly. Some of the little Christmas trees are edible, being made of gumdrops or suckers.

Dolls of all sizes, ages, and wardrobe will commandeer a special doll-town booth. Toyland will feature a wide variety of novelties to amuse the young and the not-so-young.

In a Christmas Gift Shoppe setting, various booths will feature handworked luncheon sets, pillow cases, towels, aprons and handkerchieves, as well as knitted and crocheted baby clothes, sweaters, scarves and mittens. There will be a special booth for religious articles, another for original Christmas cards designed by the Sisters of Mercy. There will be a special booth specializing in gifts for women and one featuring gifts for men. Homemade baked goods will be on sale in the gym balcony. Refreshments will be served.

Mother Mary Gabriel and Mother Mary Alphonsus will coordinate the Sisters' efforts in the sale.

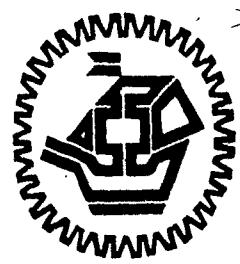
