## Two Students Nominated For U.S. Appointments

Charles F. Bellavia of 43 Windsor Road, Rochester, has been named in a second group of students eligible for appointment to the U.S. Military Academy at West Point.

## Anglicans Need New Rites Too

London — (RNS) — Reforms are needed in the Church of England and one of them is revision of forms of public worship, according to Dr. Arthur Michael Ramsey, Archbishop of Canterbury and Anglican Primate of all England.

"One of the reforms we need is reform of the liturgy and public worship," he declared. "This has already been happening, for instance, in the very considerable use of the new English Bible in Church. In the next few years I think the reform of our forms of public worship will be a very considerable task for us to set in hand." Dr. Ramsey expressed these views in an interview with Desmond Fisher, staff writer of the leading English Roman Catholic newspaper, the Catholic Herald, and its correspondent at Vatican II.

Fisher began his interview by recalling a conversation he had with an American Methodist delegate-observer at the Council. The Methodist, he said, had declared that the aggiornamento in the Roman Catholic Church, faced other Christian Churches with the challenge of initiating their own movements of reform and renewal. They could reject the challenge to their souls' harm or accept it to their minds' agony, the observer said.

Dr. Ramsey reacted to this by declaring: "I think that liturgical reform and renewal is something happening in every part of Christendom and that we can all gain immense challenge and stimulus from one another."

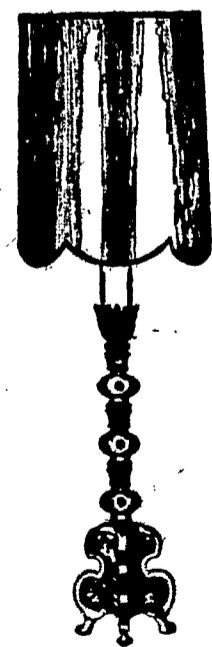

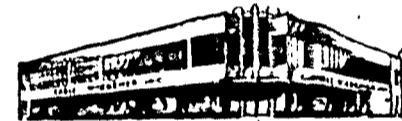
