**Father Duggan Funeral Held**

Very Reverend Sidney J. Duggan, a frequent visitor to Rochester, died at the age of 43 in Plymouth, England on December 8.

Rev. Father Duggan was ordained in Plymouth, Jan. 21, 1946. He served several parishes in England and was pastor of St. John's Church, Tiverton, for three years before his appointment as administrator of the Cathedral in Plymouth.

Besides his friends in Rochester, he was also well known by the clergy and parishioners of Holy Rosary and St. Lawrence Churches, and the members of the Ancient Order of Hibernians.

Surviving are his parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Duggan, Plymouth, England, his brother John Duggan and five nieces in Rochester, his aunts Mrs. Paul Shannon, Mrs. David Shannon and Sister M. Eamon, S.S., of Rochester, and Miss Eilly Wiseman, Mrs. Jack Kerr and his uncle John Wiseman of Ireland. Also surviving are his cousins Rt. Rev. Msgr. George F. Wiseman of Boston, Mass., and Rev. Robert Wiseman of the African Missions.

Last rites were held in the Cathedral in Plymouth, England Dec. 11 and a Solemn Requiem Mass was offered at Holy Rosary Church, Rochester on the same day.
